DIAGNOSIS:

- Extreme prematurity
- Developmental delay, mainly in speech aspect
- Autism spectrum disorder

HISTORY:

A 5 years old girl with significant neonatal course of being ex-preterm, 25 weeker, product of emergency C/S due to PV bleeding, with history of low APGAR score, birth weight was 750g, who remained in the NICU for 5 months. She also has history of cardiac lesion which was repaired at the age of one month. The patient was showing delay in her development and was referred to KFSHRC for further evaluation.

In terms of her developmental history:

Started rolling over at 12 months

Sitting at 15 months

Crawling at 16 months.

Standing at 18 months.

Walking at 20 months.

In terms of language the mother doesn't remember when she started cooing or squealing. At 8 months she was able to say MAMA and BABA but she lost them. The parents has noted low crying quality of sound at 12 months of age.

Gross > walk, run, jumps

Fine > draw vertical lines

Speech > she speak in sentences that are not understandable

INVESTIGATIONS:

Brain MRI showed unremarkable results. A metabolic work up was also sent which yielded normal results.

DISPOSITION:

The patient was following with pediatric neurology clinic in KFSHRC for evaluation of developmental delay. We have reached the diagnosis of autism spectrum disorder, a neurodevelopmental disorder characterized by persistent deficits in social communication and social interaction and restricted, repetitive patterns of behavior, interests, and activities, and advised for a rehabilitation autism center, which the parents are currently taking their child to the center regularly and seeing improvements in her condition. We advised to continue regular follow ups with the center. The child needs full financial and social support as this is a long term condition.
